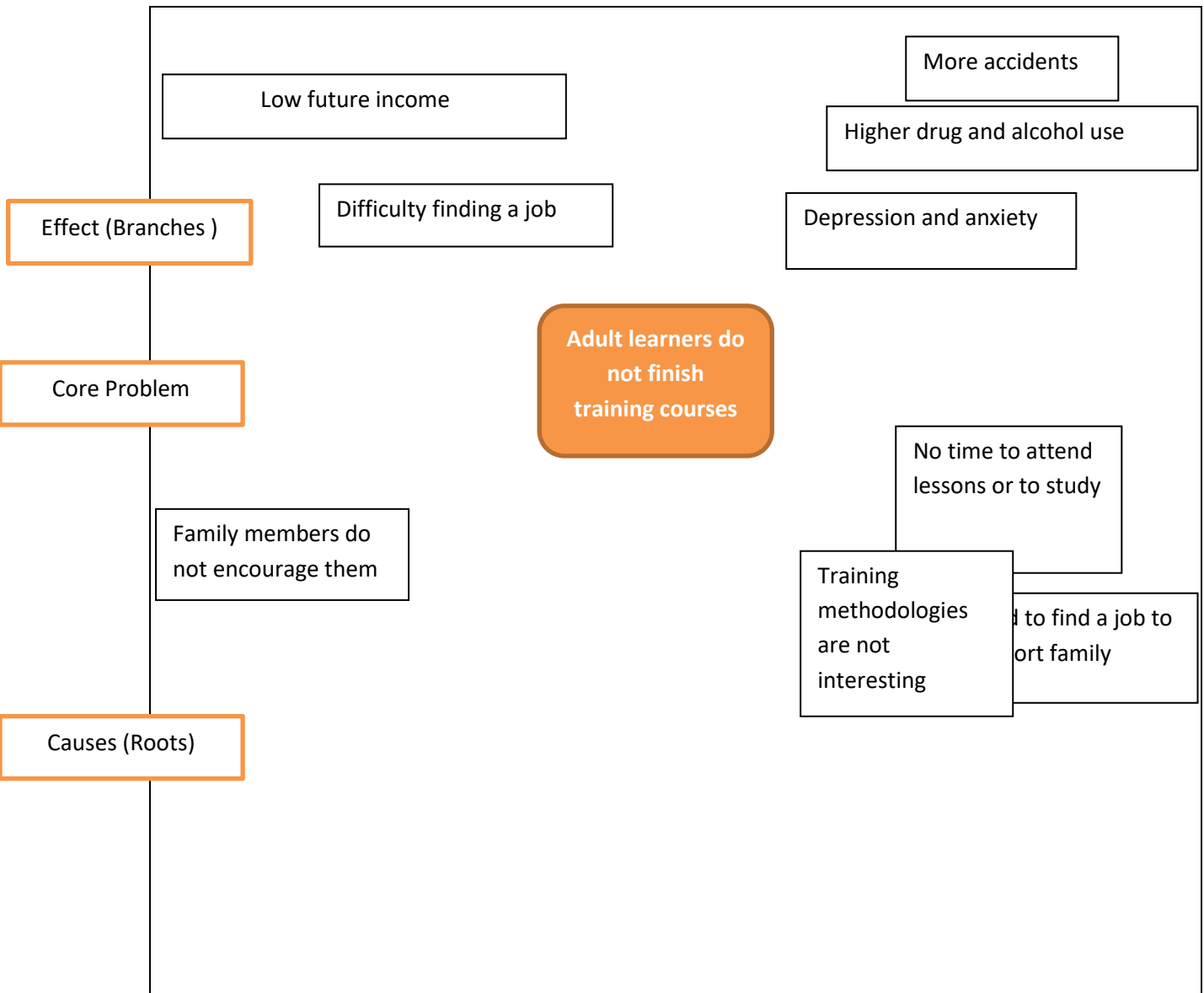
Exercise number 1
